Subject: Proposed Amendment to State Police Commission Rule 7.22

Pursuant to the provisions of State Police Commission Rule 2.10(a), the State Police Commission will hold a public hearing on April 13, 2023, to consider proposed amendments to State Police Commission Rule 7.22. The hearing will begin at 10:00 A.M. in the Veterans' Memorial Auditorium, 5825 Florida Blvd., Baton Rouge, LA, 70806.

### Summary of Proposal – SPC Rule 7.22

Please refer to the charts that follow for a comparison between the current and proposed rule language. Proposed additions appear in **blue** and omissions appear in **red**.

The proposed revision of the rule would permit an employee to retain their highest score earned between mandatory promotional examination cycles. If adopted, the score on the most current eligible list that is still in effect as of April 13, 2023, would be the baseline for implementation; the score from this list would carry forward until either a higher score is attained or until the next mandatory examination occurs.
