Subject: Performance Evaluation System - Adjusted Deadlines

State Police Commission (SPC) Rule 10.10 provides that the Director may approve exceptions to Chapter 10 rules. On August 11, 2023, Governor John Bel Edwards declared a state of emergency as a result of the imminent threat of emergency conditions that threaten the lives and property of the citizens of the State. The Department of Public Safety - Public Safety Services and members of the state police service have been tasked with working out of traditional roles in order to respond to this event. Therefore, I am extending the official evaluation deadline for the 2022-2023 performance year to September 30, 2023. As a result of this change, the deadline for employees to submit a request for Agency Review will be adjusted to October 15th. Agencies must respond to the request for Agency Review no later than November 15th.

A chart showing the current deadlines and the revised deadlines, as provided for in this General Circular, is provided below for your reference:
