Subject: State Police Commission Rule 6.13

Pursuant to the provisions of State Police Commission Rule 2.10(a), the State Police Commission will hold a public hearing on Thursday, September 21, 2000 to consider repealing and reenacting State Police Commission Rule 6.13. The hearing will begin at 9:00 a.m. in the Conference Room, Eleventh Floor, Wooddale Towers Building, 1835 Wooddale Boulevard, Baton Rouge, Louisiana. These changes are necessary to begin implementation of the new Systems Applications Products (SAP) program.

6.13 Certification and Payment.

- (a) No employee shall receive any compensation except as authorized by or pursuant to the provisions of Article X, the State Police Commission Rules, the Uniform Classification and Pay Plans, and the policies and procedures issued by the Director.
- (b) If payments to an employee are found to have been made in violation of the provisions of Article X, the State Police Commission Rules, the Uniform Classification and Pay Plans, or the policies and procedures issued by the Director, the Director may take any corrective action deemed appropriate or may direct the appointing authority to take such corrective action. Corrective actions may include, but are not limited to, the rescinding of any actions and associated compensation, or restitution to the employee.

Please review this proposal and furnish, in writing, by September 10, 2000 any comments which you consider pertinent. If you would like to appear before the Commission and present your comments orally, you are invited to do so. You must notify this office by September 10, 2000 of your intention to address the Commission, in order to be placed or the agenda.

Please post this General C-rcular prominently, so that all employees will receive notice of this hearing. If any special accommodations are needed, please notify us prior to the hearing date.
